## ANYTHING GOES

## MONTH 1

Begin collecting $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch strips of fabric in your choice of background color. I am using white/cream background fabrics, but you can use whatever you desire. Gray tones, beige, pastels, or a combination of all will work.

For this project you will need a total of $1811 / 2$ inch width of fabric strips. We will not be using these strips until the last clue, so you can audition strips at your leisure. You will want a variety of strips, but it is perfectly fine to repeat your favorites.

## $21 ⁄ 2$ Inch Quarter Square Triangles 2 Inch Finished

Using Cheat Sheet. Cut (4) 3 ½ inch squares of 4 different fabrics. Please take care not to choose one of the background strip fabrics. You want this to be scrappy.

If you cannot do scrappy, I totally understand. I have a tendency to think that a charm pack is scrappy. Enough said.

Follow the directions on the back of the Cheat Sheet to sew (4) $21 / 2$ inch unfinished quarter square triangles.

This is meant to be a fun project that will not consume all your time. After all, it is a Quilt Show Year.
