

Quilt Show Label Instructions

Placement of Label

Usually, quilt labels are placed on the bottom left corner of the quilt back, when you are looking at the back of the quilt (the right bottom corner if you are looking at it from the front).

Content of Label

There are no requirements for labeling at RQG Shows, however, it is good practice for quilt labels to include the following as a MINIMUM:

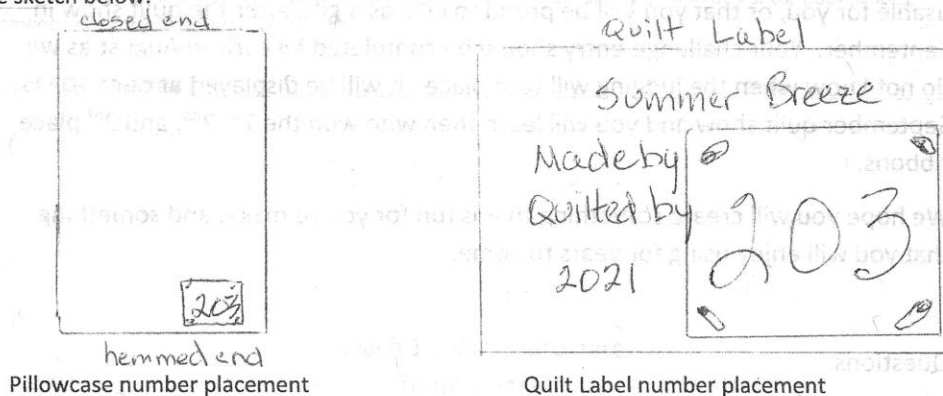
Name of Quilt
Quilt Maker's Name
Quilter's Name (if not the quilt maker)
Place where Quiltmaker lives
Year quilt completed

Other items to consider including:

- Street address and phone of quilt owner is usually required for entry into larger quilt shows.
- Any special designation (date of special occasion with significance, such as Presented to Jane Emily Doe and Mark David Doe on the Occasion of their Wedding, May 1, 2021).
- Name of pattern or fabric collection if it is of some significance.

Where do I place the numbers I get for the RQG Show entries?

Each quilt entered in the Show must be placed in its own pillowcase/fabric case (no noodles, please). The number label needs to be placed on the pillowcase/fabric case with **FOUR 1" safety pins (one in each corner)** per the sketch below.

Quilt Label number placement

If the quilt is being judged, the second label goes on the quilt label to cover up the quilt maker and quilter info, and anything else on the label that might indicate the owner. This means it should be on the bottom right corner of the quilt when you are looking at the **FRONT** of the quilt. If you have your label in another location, but sure to pin a plain piece of fabric over the label so no names, addresses, or other identifiers are visible. Pin this number using **FOUR 1" safety pins (1 in each corner)** per the sketch above. If the number label doesn't cover the identification information, then pin an additional fabric covering over the label prior to placing the number label.
