

## ScrapTastic Fun!

Yes, I think we just made up a new word! Raintree Quilters Guild is always looking for some new, fun, challenging activity, and we think we have stumbled onto something that everyone can participate in and enjoy.

Each member who chooses to participate will fill out a form and indicate their preference of what another (randomly chosen) member will make from the scraps you choose to put in your bag – a pincushion, a small wall hanging (10" x 10" max), a mug rug/table mat (10" x 10" max), OR "any of the above". The bags will be regular brown paper lunch bags (think small) and will be provided, as will the information cards. Everyone will have 2 months to complete the item and return it at the regular meeting where we will open our new scrappy surprises! So, someone will make you a gift, from your fabric, and it can be a complete surprise or you can specify what type of surprise you want! Everyone who brings a scrap bag will take a bag and make a surprise for someone else.

Here's the steps and the timetable:

Month	Activity
November/ December	<b>Signup</b> with Christy or Donna to participate and get your bag and card. Fill out the card and collect your "scraps". If you want, decide which of the items you need/want that are on the list. DO NOT write on or mark on the outside of the bag.
January	<b>Bring</b> your bag of scraps with the card filled out to the meeting and give it to Christy and Donna at the beginning of the meeting. During the meeting the bags will be numbered so that no one knows who is getting whose bag. At the end of the meeting, <b>randomly pick out a bag</b> and keep it a secret whose you have! <b>Give the number</b> of your bag to Christy or Donna.
March	<b>Bring</b> your ScrapTastic Fun project and give it to Christy or Donna who will place it on the table with the card showing whose it is, what they requested, who made it, and what is the result. These will stay on the table throughout the meeting so everyone can see all the creative, fun, scrappy things that have been created! At the end of the meeting everyone gets to <b>take their scrappy gift home</b> .

### Additional Info:

- Keep your bag, contents, and whose it is a secret!
- If your person requests something you don't know how to make, such as a pincushion, either learn how to make one via Pinterest, a new pattern, or a friend, **OR** find someone to swap the bag with for a project you are comfortable making (without telling them who owns the bag). Be sure to tell Christy or Donna about your swap (you will need to give them the number of the bag).
